# **Exploring courses**

# **VIA VTAC**

Use the Course Search function on the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) website to search all undergraduate law courses in the state. Please be aware that this information is for the 2024 selection period and Selection Ranks may change for the 2025 selection period.

Go to www.vtac.edu.au Click on Course Search Enter in key terms such as Law Use the 'advanced search' function to narrow your options.

# How to become a lawyer in Victoria

# **STEP 1: ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION**

Complete one of the following accredited qualifications:

Undergraduate entry Bachelor of Laws (LLB)

Graduate entry Bachelor of Laws (Graduate Entry) Juris Doctor (JD)

# **STEP 2: PRACTICAL LEGAL TRAINING**

Complete practical legal training

## **Option 1**

Complete a practical legal training course conducted by a practical legal training provider accredited by the Victorian Legal Admissions Board. The following four providers are currently accredited:

Leo Cussen Centre for Law

The College of Law Swinburne University in partnership with Leo Cussen Australian College of Applied Professions with the Law Institute of Australia

# Option 2

Complete supervised legal training in a workplace for a period of not less than 12 months, under a training plan approved by the Victorian Legal Admissions Board.

# **STEP 3: ADMISSION TO PRACTICE**

Apply for admission with the Victorian Legal Admissions Board and follow all steps to receive your Compliance Certificate.



# What ATAR will I need?

When it comes to the ATAR, there are three ways Year 12 leavers can gain direct entry into a law degree in Victoria – achieving a selection rank above the lowest rank for the relevant intake, achieving above the guaranteed ATAR, or receiving a place in the ACU Guarantee program. Note: information below is based on the 2024 intake and may change for the 2025 intake.

## SELECTION RANK

Universities use the 'selection rank' when assessing course applications.

The selection rank is your ATAR plus any adjustments made by the uni (e.g., equity and academic adjustments).

Your selection rank will be different for each course at each university as each institute uses their own adjustment programs.

You won't know what your selection rank is, but you'll need to achieve a rank above the 'lowest selection rank' for the relevant intake year.

## **GUARANTEED ATAR**

These universities have a 'guaranteed ATAR' program. Some ATARs haven't been confirmed for the 2025 intake yet.

# **NO ATAR**

Australian Catholic University offers the Bachelor of Laws at the Melbourne campus.

They have an early entry program called '<u>ACU Guarantee</u>'. Successful applicants can receive a conditional 'ATAR free' offer for the course through this program.

The University calculates a selection rank using your Year 11 grades. The selection rank can be boosted by providing up to three personal statements.

The conditions of the early offer program are successfully completing Year 12, achieving course prerequisites, and ordering your VTAC preferences correctly.

Applications will open in July 2024 (to be confirmed).

# **GRADUATE DEGREE PACKAGES**

Graduate Degree Packages comprise an undergraduate degree from the University of Melbourne followed by the Juris Doctor. The following packages are available:

Bachelor of Agriculture + Law Bachelor of Arts + Law Bachelor of Biomedicine + Law Bachelor of Commerce + Law Bachelor of Design + Law Bachelor of Science + Law

Applicants will need to achieve an ATAR of at least 99.80 to be eligible. Apply for the graduate packages via the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) from Monday 29 July.

Timely applications close Monday 30 September, but courses can be added to your preference list after this. December offers will be released on 23 December.



## MELBOURNE CHANCELLOR'S SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants who apply for a University of Melbourne undergraduate degree via VTAC, achieve an ATAR of at least 99.90 (Indigenous Australian – 90.00), and study in the year after they graduate from Year 12 VCE will be eligible for the Melbourne Chancellor's Scholarship.

Among other benefits, successful applicants will receive a guaranteed Commonwealth Supported Place in the Melbourne Juris Doctor.
